Reducing malnutrition is simple with 4 steps

1

Improve your Anganwadi's basic infrastructure using the checklist provided

2

If the food quantity at your Anganwadi is poor, tie-up with the Akshaya Patra Foundation to supply additional food items to your Anganwadi

3

Initiate 'Healthiest Child' award and 'Healthiest Mother' award at your Anganwadi

4

Give a call to your Anganwadi once a month to ensure no child falls in the red (malnourished) zone

5

Send in a small team of employees to visit & teach at your Anganwadi for 2-3 hours every fortnight

Improve the basic infrastructure at your Anganwadi

Follow this checklist of essential items

BASIC INFRASTRUCTURE

- Drinking water
- Soap to wash hands
- Kitchen utensils, eating plates and gas connection
- Weighing machine for children
- Concrete flooring and Floor mats. Desks are preferred.
- Ceiling Fan or Table Fan
- Concrete, painted walls

LEARNING MATERIAL

- Play materials (playing blocks, toys & coloring books)
- Study material (notebooks, storybooks, flash cards & workbooks)
- Stationery (pencils, erasers, sharpeners, crayons & sketch pens)

A PRIORITY

- Toilet

Increase the food quantity at your Anganwadi

- If your Anganwadi is suffering from inadequate food quantity, you can tie-up with the the **Akshaya Patra Foundation** to supply additional food items
- Akshaya Patra is one of India's top NGOs supplying nutritious mid-day meals to 1.3 million children every day at Government Schools. It runs state-of-the art kitchens in 19 locations spread across 9 states.
- Your corporation can arrange for Akshaya Patra to start distributing food items to your Anganwadi in Hyderabad as well. Akshaya Patra is already supplying hot meals to Anganwadi Centers in the Ranga Reddy district of Andhra Pradesh in partnership with the State Government.

Initiate 'Healthiest Child' Award and 'Healthiest Mother' Award

Give away these awards every month at your Anganwadi (in cash or in kind). These awards motivate mothers to regularly avail of the Anganwadi's services and to take proper home-care.

Monitor your Anganwadi once a month

Just give a call to your Anganwadi worker once a month to check if any of your kids have fallen in the red (malnourished) zone and if so, address the specific issue.



5

Optional but Recommended

Send in a small team of employees to teach & interact with your Anganwadi kids

For just 2-3 hours every fortnight, a few of your employees can have a fulfilling time teaching and playing with the children at your Anganwadi.
